Applications are now being accepted from visual artists across the New England Region for the inaugural **2018 Helen Dangar Memorial Art Bursary**. The bursary will be awarded to support a professional or creative development opportunity that will assist the successful artist to improve their skills, learn new techniques or broaden their artistic horizons. The bursary will be open to artists of all skill levels – from young and emerging artists to experienced creators.

Bursary Award:

The Bursary Award for 2017/18 is AUD\$1,500 which can be used to cover attendance fees, travel and accommodation.

What can you use the bursary for?

The bursary can be used to support travel and attendance at a self-devised professional development activity. Your activity must be completed by **31st December 2019**. Activities may include funding support to attend a:

- workshop
- residency
- conference
- masterclass
- course

which will assist you to develop your artistic practice. ***Please tell us what you want to do, why you want to attend and how it will help you in your artistic pursuits.***
