Applications are now being accepted from visual artists across the New England Region for the **2020 Helen Dangar Memorial Art Bursary.** The bursary will be awarded to support a professional or creative development opportunity that will assist the successful artist to improve their skills, learn new techniques or broaden their artistic horizons. The bursary will be open to artists of all skill levels – from young and emerging artists to experienced creators.

## **Bursary Award:**

The Bursary Award for 2020/21 is AUD\$2,000 which can be used to cover attendance fees, travel and accommodation.

## What can you use the bursary for?

The bursary can be used to support travel and attendance at a self-devised professional development activity. Due to travel and other restrictions imposed by COVID-19, online development activities are also eligible. Your activity must be completed by **31st December 2021.** Changes to proposed activity due to COVID-19 restirctions may be negotiated.

Activities may include funding support to attend a:

- workshop
- residency
- conference
- masterclass
- course
