Early Stage 1 – Stage 2

Stage 1: Appreciating

VAS1.3: Realises what artists do, who they are and what they make.

VAS1.4: Begins to interpret the meaning of artworks, acknowledging the roles of artist and audience.

Stage 1: Making

VAS1.1: Makes artworks in a particular way about experiences of real and imaginary things.

VAS1.2: Uses the forms to make artworks according to varying requirements.

Stage 2: Appreciating

VAS2.3: Acknowledges that artists make artworks for different reasons and that various interpretations are possible.

VAS2.4: Identifies connections between subject matter in artworks and what they refer to, and appreciates the use of particular techniques.
