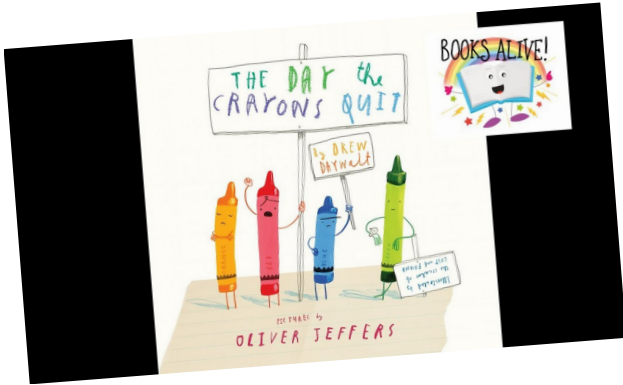


THE DAY THE CRAYONS QUIT

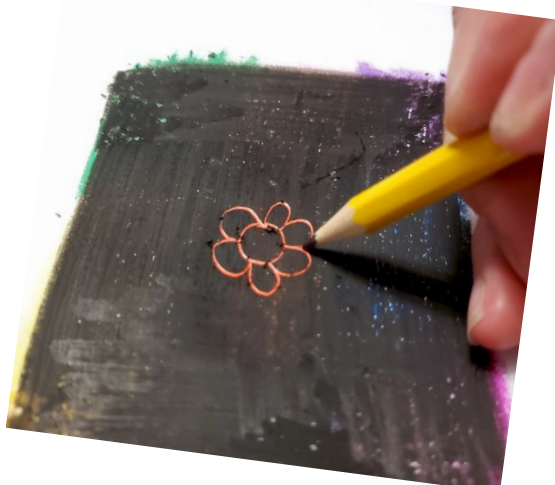
Next we have three fun art activities to do!

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- White Paper, card or paper plates.
- Crayons .
- Black paint.
- Printer.
- Scissors.
- Spaghetti or Noodles.
- Food colouring

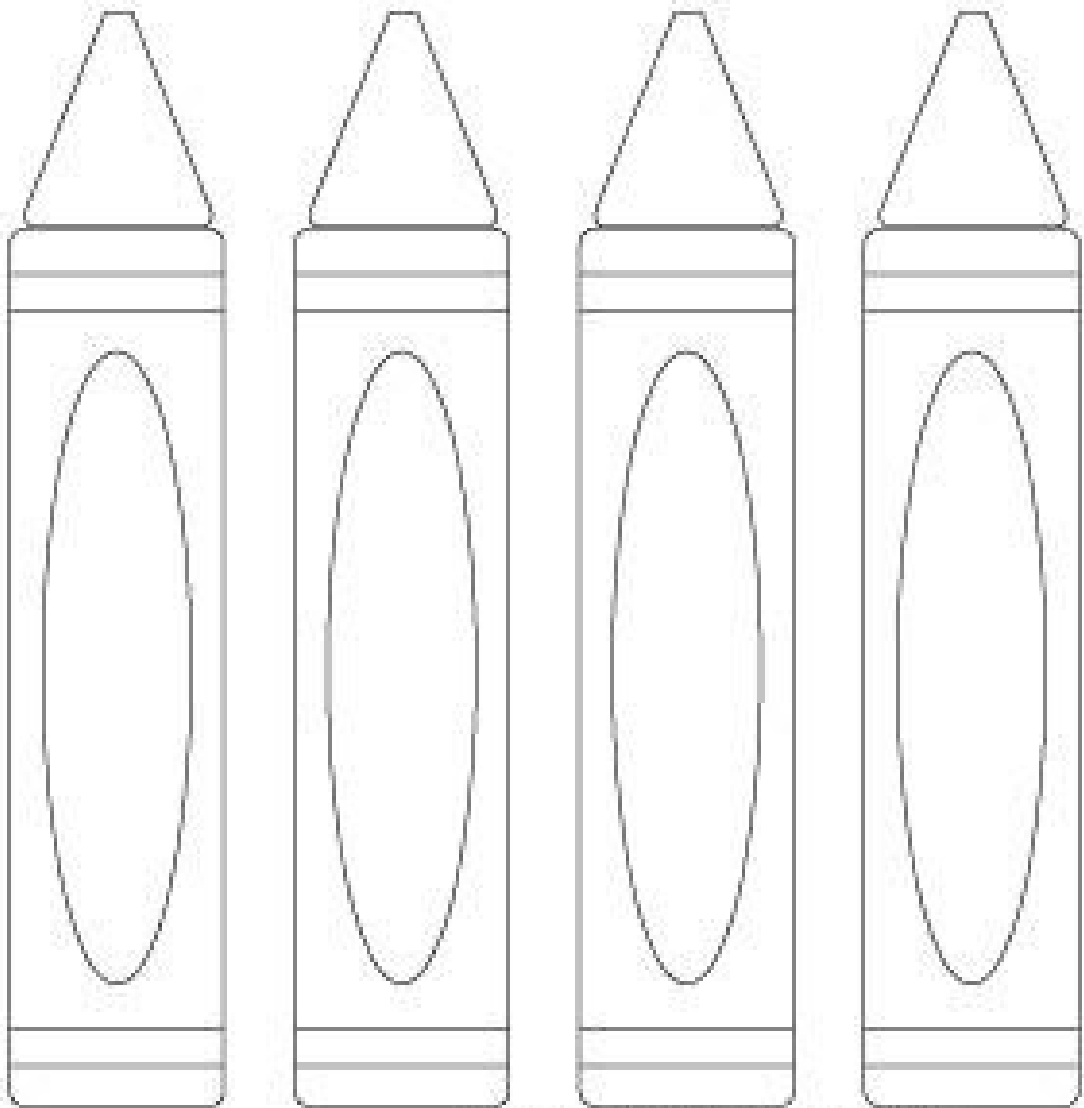
1. Art Scratch Cards

1. Take a piece of white paper or a paper plate.
2. Colour it all over with crayons of lots of colours.
3. Paint over the entire paper/plate with black paint.
4. Leave it to dry.
5. Once dried take a pencil or something with a pointy end and scratch drawings into it, revealing the rainbow colours underneath

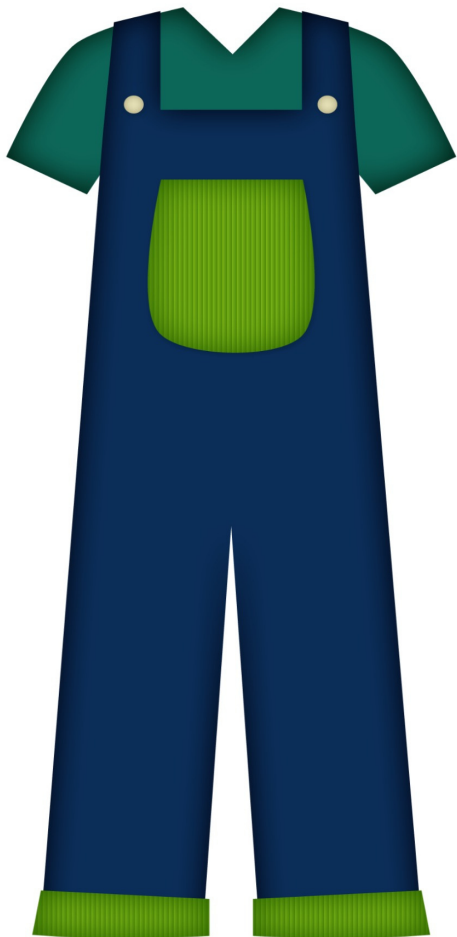
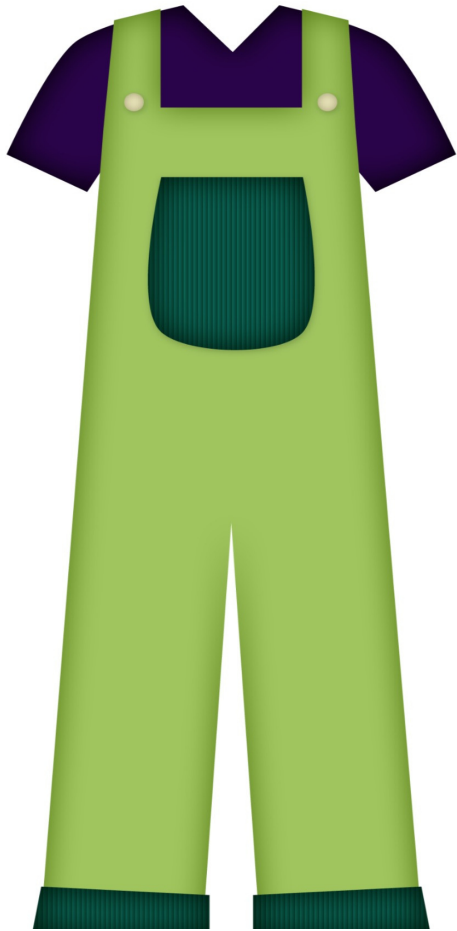


2. Making Crayon People

Print this page, then cut out the crayons and colour the tops, give them a face...



Print this page and cut out the crayon clothes and glue them to the crayons



3. **Sensory Coloured Noodles**

1. Cook spaghetti or noodles as you would to eat.
2. Once boiled and softened, pour most of the hot water out of the pan, leaving just a little water left over.
3. Seperate noodles and water into 4 different bowls
4. Add different food colouring to each bowl and let it sit to dye the noodles.
5. Test to see if the colour has set then discard water, lay on paper towel to dry
6. Add noodles to big tray ready for fun play!
