Event Organiser: NERAM Timings for Maker's Stalls during the Event

- Stall set-up from 7:30 — 9:00am.
- Stallholders that arrive after 9:15am will be refused entry to the allocated market site. All set-up must be completed by 9:30am including vehicles off site
- All vehicles to be removed from stall site area before 9:30am and relocated to the designated parking area.
- There is allocated parking at the venue for market stall holders, unless previously approved by NERAM.
- A sitemap will be issued in a separate email. Please bring this document with you on the day for easy reference/location.
- Stall holders are to be ready to trade from 10:00am.
- Market trading time: 10:00am — 4:00pm.
- Pack-down not to commence before 3:00pm.
- NERAM Staff and Volunteers will be identifiable by the fluorescent T-Shirt labelled "NERAM Crew" for any liaison required during this event.

Stall Bookings

- **ABSOLUTELY NO PARKING ON KENTUCKY STREET.** Armidale Regional Council has not approved a DA application for Kentucky St parking for this event.
- With a focus on the environment, we request that there are NO single use plastics used by stall holders for this event. This complies with the nature of the event promoting sustainability.
- The booking fee includes grassed space of up to 3m x 3m, unless otherwise noted on Maker's Market application form as a special requirement.
- Stall holders must supply their own marquees/shade, chairs, secure storage for cash and all other display equipment.
- No power cords are supplied by NERAM.
- Power output (one plug-in point) only will be supplied as pre-arranged with NERAM and is prioritised for food stalls.
- Sellers must be available to work the full duration of the market and must not start packing up before 3:00pm.
- Sellers are required to arrive at the venue from 7:30— 9:00am in order to set up in proper manner and must be ready to sell by the start time of 10:00am.
- Any stall owners who arrive after 9:15am will not be granted entry to their market site. This timeline is not negotiable.
- Sellers must remove all unsold items, display equipment and clear all rubbish from their stall area no later than 5:00pm.

Stall Payments

- Payments must be made in advance and settled by 4pm Friday 16 October
- 2026. This event will go ahead Rain, Hail or Shine. No Show/No Refund.

Market Cancellations

- This event will proceed regardless of weather conditions. Stall holders may make their own decision to attend or not. No refunds given.
- If a cancellation occurs due to COVID-19 NSW Government Health orders a full refund will be issued.

Stall Allocation

- All stalls have been arranged and allocated by NERAM.
- Stall applicants were drawn from a hat to allocate their site location, with the exception of food stalls requiring a power supply from the NERAM building.
- Stallholders must not swap stalls.
- Failure to comply will result in refusal of entry.

Goods For Sale

- It is NERAM's legal obligation to ensure stall holders do not to sell items with missing parts, anything which is broken, stained, ripped, deemed to be dangerous, or generally in poor condition to our community.
- If you have items on your stall that does not meet this requirement you will be asked to remove them.

Business and Craft Stallholders

- Maker's stallholders to only sell items that fit the Maker's Market criteria.
- All business stalls must trade legally, safely, and comply with all laws related to running a business.
- All Stallholders must ensure that their stall and any displays are set up safely for themselves and the general public.

Transactions

- NERAM will have no involvement and will accept no responsibility for any transaction agreement entered into at a market (eg. a payment plan for items purchased).

Disagreements

- NERAM will accept no responsibility for any disputes between stallholders and customers, although will reserve the right to reach an authoritative judgement.

Security

- NERAM will accept no responsibility for the damage, loss, or theft of any item bought into the venue.
- All stallholders are responsible for their own stall security and monies. All persons who enter the market area do so at their own risk.

Liability

- The stallholder agrees to indemnify NERAM against all claims for damages to the property or injury to any person in respect of any claim by any such person arising out of any faulty or dangerous products sold by the stallholder or stallholder's assistant/helper.

Health and Safety

- NERAM aims to provide, maintain, and promote high standards of health, safety and welfare at all events.
- To ensure these conditions are met all stallholders are responsible for the safety of their stall/table, i.e. setting up in a safe and secure manner to avoid accidents and all activities that take place on their stall throughout the event.
- Stallholders who do not follow these conditions will be asked to leave the event.
- If you choose to bring children along to the event, it is the stallholder's responsibility to ensure their safety and wellbeing is met at all times during the event.
- The stallholder agrees to indemnify NERAM against all claims arising out of negligence on the part of the stallholder and/or their assistants/helpers.

Illegal Activity

- NERAM will accept no responsibility for the non-compliance by a stallholder and/or their assistants/helpers.
- Friends of NERAM are the only attendees permitted to sell alcohol, under the use of NERAM's Alcohol License. Alcohol sold by Friends of NERAM is only to be consumed in the designated area.
- No drinking of alcohol or use of illegal drugs on market premises. No Smoking on creeklands or within 8 meters of the NERAM building.
- No sale of equipment intended for illegal drug use.
